SELECTED ACHIEVEMENTS

United Way of Greater Topeka, Campaign for Grade Level Reading Summer Literacy Project: In my role as the AmeriCorps Volunteer In Service To America (VISTA) Campaign for Grade Level Reading (CGLR) Program Director, I forged an alliance with Raise Kansas on a Summer Literacy Project. A summer subcommittee was created to provide a forum to address summer learning loss and the immediate issues hindering the access to resources for 2015. New partnerships and collaborations to expand the capacity of existing programs as well as the piloting of new and innovative sustainable future programs happened organically between partners. I recruited and engaged new volunteers in the work. I applied for and received a summer learning grant.

Results: 3,590 books were collected. Several local libraries were supplied with books. Approximately 2,200 children were served.

American Red Cross Southwest Service Area, Supervised Feeding of Staff and Volunteers during Hurricane Katrina Astrodome: Evacuees fleeing Louisiana as a result from Hurricane Katrina came into Texas seeking shelter. The State of Texas asked the American Red Cross to help in the management of the site that expected 30,000 evacuees to arrive. I was responsible for providing meals for all the staff and all local, national and international incoming volunteers at the Greater Houston Area Chapter. As part of the management team, I help to organize and implement the sheltering solution for those affected by the hurricane. I supervised a team of volunteers and prepared for the feeding of 500 meals and snacks per day. In addition, I ordered office, logistical supplies, managed inventory and solicited in-kind donations from local vendors. I continued daily support for the overall management, staff, and volunteers with office administrative functions as needed.

Results: 10,000 people received food and supplies during the disaster relief operation.
